Introduction

Star Textile Processing Industries is a well-established, family-owned textile manufacturing company incorporated in 1986, with a long-standing reputation in Sri Lanka’s textile industry. Over the years, the company has built its strength on disciplined scheduling, efficient sequencing, and a consistent commitment to quality and reliability.

Our manufacturing operations cater to both local and export markets, producing a wide range of weft knitted fabrics and woven fabrics. The greige production facility, spanning over 80,000 square feet, is located within the Industrial Development Board Zone in Ekala, Ja-Ela, while our dyeing and finishing facility is situated along Divulapitiya Road, Negombo. This strategic setup allows us to maintain tight process control from raw fabric to finished output.

Annually, Star Textile manufactures over 600,000kg of knitted fabrics, including Interlock, Lacoste, Pique, and Single Jersey, as well as more than 2.4 million meters of woven fabrics, such as Suiting, Curtains, Bedsheets, Workwear Uniforms, and Static Wear. Our focus on structured operations and process efficiency has earned us recognition for product quality and dependable service across the industry.

Knit fabric is a textile that results from inter-looping(Knitting)yarn together with long needles. Knit fabric falls into two categories: weft knitting and warp knitting.

3 FABRIC DYEING

Finishing refers to the processes that convert the woven or knitted cloth into a usable material and more specifically to any process performed after dyeing the fabric to improve the look, performance.

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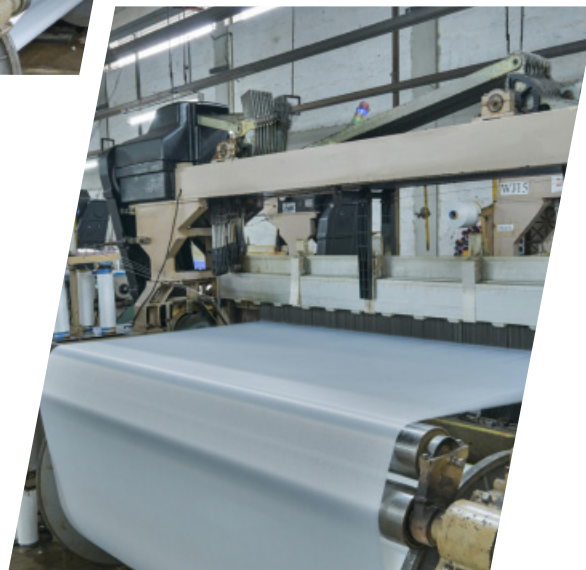

Our 100% polyester woven fabrics include Suiting, Sujeen, Butter Silk, Pongee, Pajero, Yellow Line, Gabardine, and Satin—widely used for apparel, uniforms, and decorative applications where strength, finish, and colour retention are essential.

We also produce 65/35 poly-cotton plain and twill fabrics, suitable for Bedsheets, Shirting, and Sarongs, combining the breathability of cotton with the durability of polyester. With controlled manufacturing processes and a strong focus on quality, Star Textile ensures reliable fabric consistency, finish, and delivery.

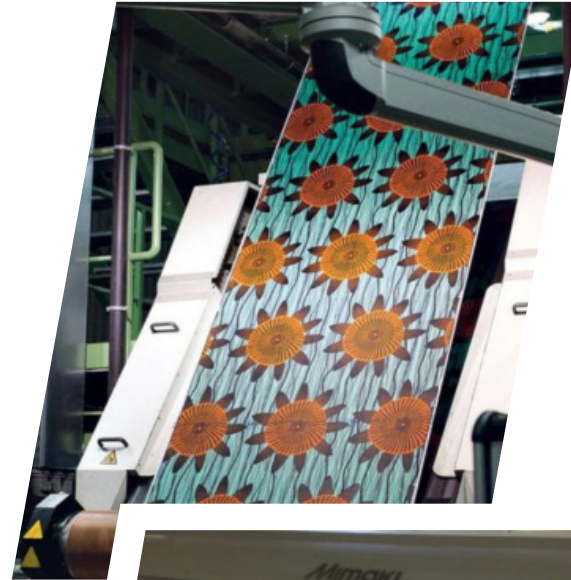

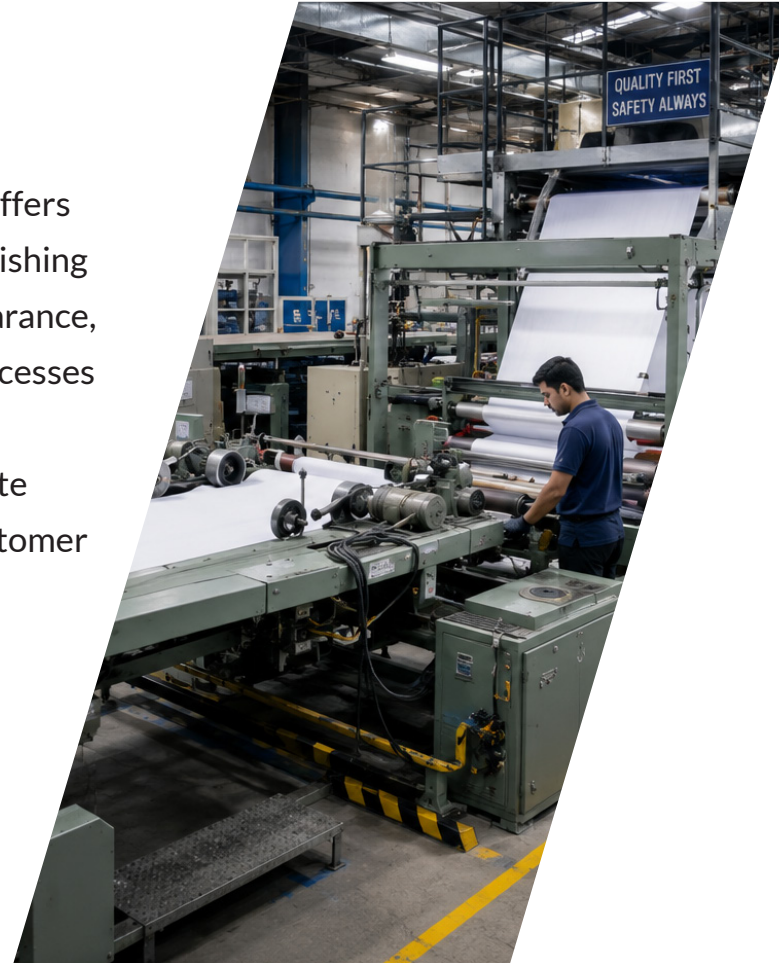
